




709 Toronto Signals, RCACC, 65th Annual Ceremonial Review

The Cadets were in fine form, and had the honour of having Lieutenant-General Richard Rohmer, the Honourary Lieutenant-General of the Canadian Armed Forces as their Reviewing Officer. LGen Rohmer, 99 years, is a Second World War Fighter Reconnaissance Pilot, who went on to become the Chief of Reserves and has served 81 years in uniform since his enrolment in the RCAF on his 18<sup>th</sup> birthday!
